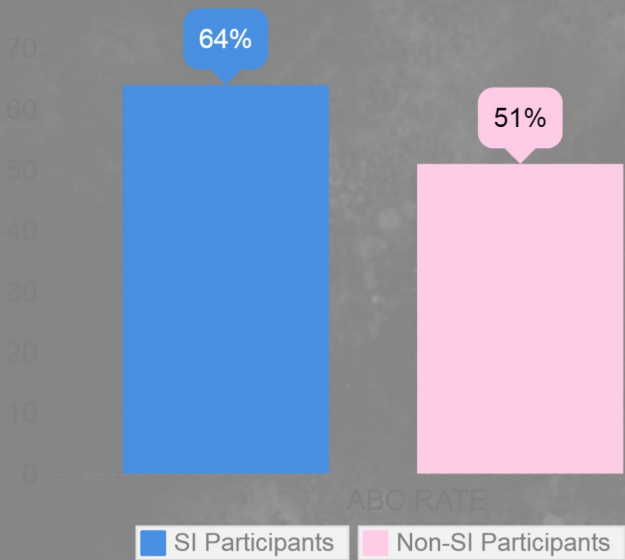


IMPACT OF SI ON GRADES FALL 2014

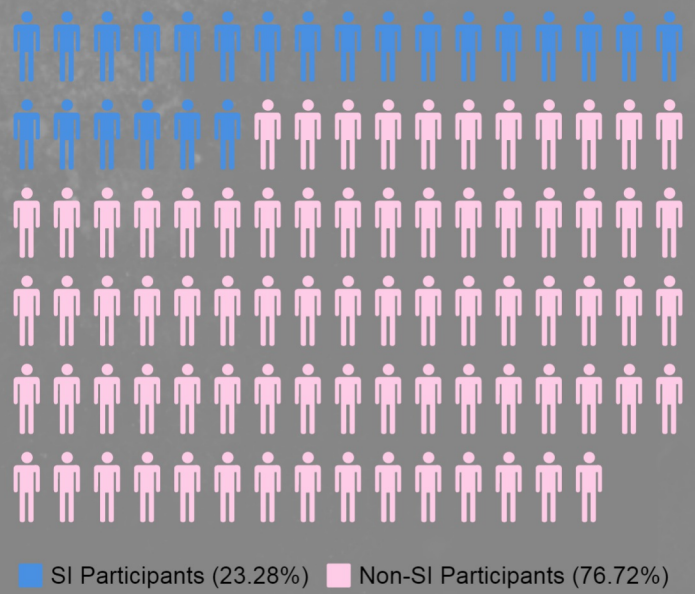
OVERVIEW



In Fall 2014, the University of Houston-Downtown SI Program offered over 1,900 sessions with an average of 2 student attending per session.

Across all sections, 66% of students who attended SI came to sessions more than once.

Withdrawals ▼



The data above represents the percentage of withdrawals per group divided by the total number of students in SI sections who withdrew.

- **41%** Overall attendance to SI sessions
- **3258** Number of contact hours
- **0.5** GPA difference between SI participants and non-participants

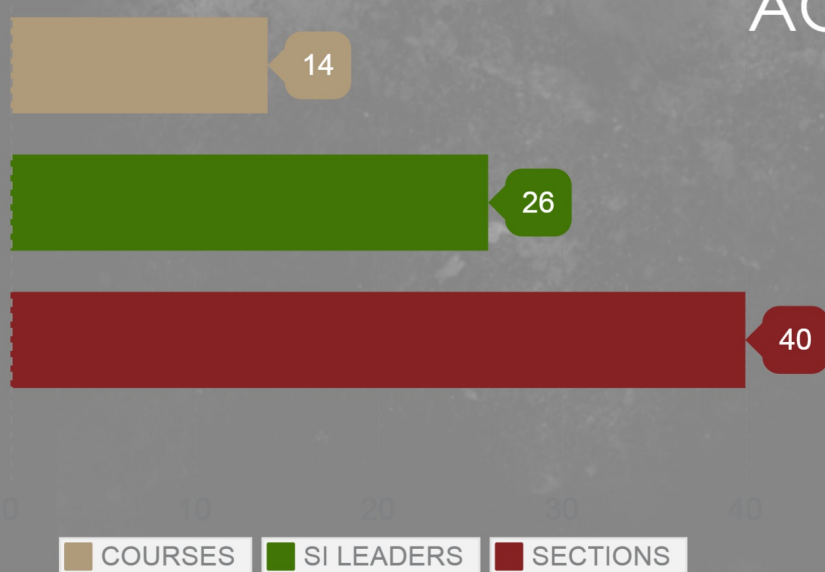
